It's hosting parties with Santa Claus during the holidays for the children.

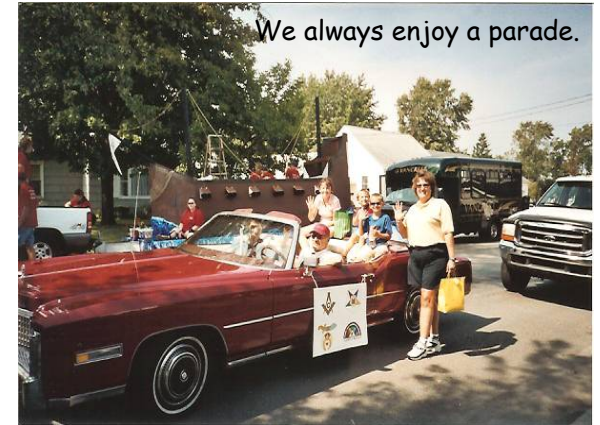


It's supporting cancer and heart research. It's giving to support students going into the ministry by holding fundraisers like noodle making, pie making, craft shows and many other projects.
